Please tell us a little about your programs presented during the past year, any special projects and/or accomplishments, and awards or recognition of the organization or its members.

**The Milan BPW met every month on 4<sup>th</sup> Monday night since June 2012 (last annual report.) Meetings have normally been held at 6:00 p.m., but during the winter months, we found that noon meetings worked better for some members. We currently have seven (7) members, but normally only 4-6 attend the meetings. This makes it difficult to plan programs, especially with an outside speaker. We have placed notices of the meetings in the local paper, and personally invited**

**others to join us, but had no reponse. Younger women say they don't have the time, especially those with children. Older women want to see their grandchildren's sports games. So, we have not been able to recruit new members.**

We take items that can be used by the women and children plus things such as toiletries. A picture and article were submitted to the Achiever in September 2012. We are planning another trip in May 2013.**

**The Milan President participated in the Region III meeting on March 9, 2013 by conference call.**

**The future of our club is uncertain. The current President has held the office for five years. None of the other six members will take the position.**
